THIS IS THE MESSAGE GIVEN BY TAYLOR HAUCK ON YOUTH SUNDAY

Good Morning everybody,

Abby just read you two verses about what faith is. We know what faith is, but sometimes that faith is tested. Sometimes we are asked to face situations that make us wonder, where is God? What is His plan? Why is he asking me to walk this journey? We all know the truth that life can be hard. I mean you look around and see people struggling all the time. The middle school girl being bullied to the point she tries to hurt herself. The young couple who lost a child. The wife and mother who finds out she has cancer. The father and husband who just lost his job. How many times do we feel as though God has abandoned us, we worry and are afraid of what tomorrow will bring. Even those who are strong in their faith struggle at times. But in that time of desperation there are a few things we need to remember, things we need to know about God and His promises. We can find those promises and discover God's character in His Word. What do I know about God? He will never abandon you! Deuteronomy 31:8, says, "The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged." Right there, God promises us that he will never leave or forsake us, so we should not be afraid or discouraged, because he is with us. What else do we know about God? He cares about us. 1 Peter 5:7, says "Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you." So God is saying that you don't need to hold upon you the weight of whatever is going on in your life, but instead can lift it up to the Lord and he will take care of it. He's telling us not to worry, not to stress, turn it over to Him. Let Him carry it. Our problems are not bigger than our God. He loves us so much and he wants to carry our burdens. Just like a parent would do whatever they could to help their child, God promises us that too. Another promise God says in John 16:33, "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." God is telling us that he has the victory over sin and death and bullies and cancer and everything else bad in this world, and because of our faith in him we have the victory too. We have life in Christ, if we accept Him as our Savior. God loves us. He loves us so much, He sent his only Son into the world, to endure the hardships that we must endure, and even more so by being crucified and dying. He did this, for us, with all of our imperfections and struggles and sins. He still offers His grace. Romans 3:23 says "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" and Ephesians 2:8-9 says "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. " How amazing is this promise, that despite how

gives us His grace. Jesus died for us, but even better, He rose from the dead and ascended into Heaven and now lives. And Jesus has promised that we will be with him in heaven. In John 14, verses 2 and 3, Jesus says, "My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am." Yes, there are times when living in this world can be rough, but for those who know Jesus, we have the promise of a special place in heaven, where there is no more death, grief, sickness, and pain. It doesn't matter if you are 8 or 80, we all struggle sometimes with our faith, but we must never forget these promises that God had revealed to us through His word and tell us about who He is. And I just want to share with everyone who is going through a struggle in their life, and they don't know what tomorrow holds. Remember Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you, not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." God knows the future, and His plans for us are good and full of hope. As long as God, who knows the future, provides our agenda and goes with us as we fulfill His mission, we can have boundless hope. This does not mean that we will be spared pain, suffering, or hardship, but that God will see us through to a glorious conclusion. You may think, but how can I get through this, how can I deal with whatever God is asking me to deal with. Remember Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength." We can't do it on our own. We can't even have faith on our own. We need God. And because we need Him, we need to know Him.

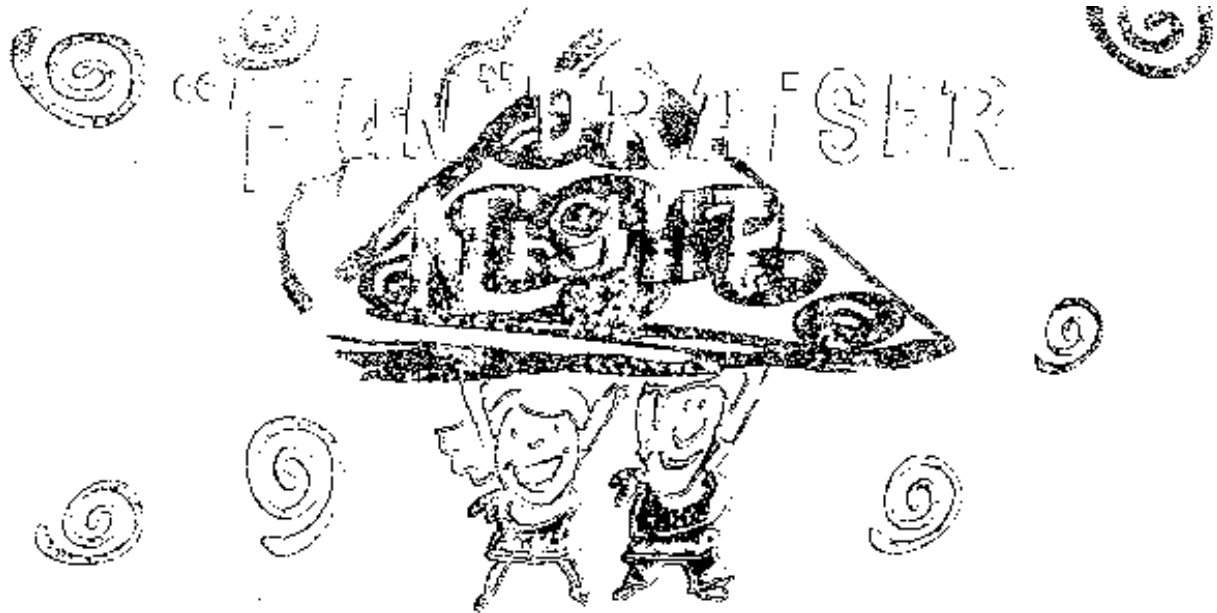


