The Repeat Offender

In Luke 15: 11-32 we read about the prodigal son, the brother, and the loving and forgiving father. We read about the younger son that wanted his inheritance from his father immediately before his father even died. The father granted his wishes and the son foolishly spent the inheritance with a wild life style and eventually was beyond being broke.

The father welcomed him back through love and grace. Several questions we may want to ask. Do we think the father wanted to see his son go through poverty and hunger? Do we think the father should have simply forgiven his son for all the misery and hardships and the heartbreak he caused his family?

The father without question welcomed his son back to the family! What can we learn from the father? Would the son ever have come back without forgiveness and grace? Did the son deserve grace from the father? Author Steve Brown writes, "Children will run from law, and they'll run from grace. The ones who run from law rarely come back, but those who run from grace always come back."

What is Grace?

One author writes "Grace is unconditional acceptance given to an undeserving person by an unobligated giver."
