Ministry through Faith,
Vision, and Action

This past week was our Vacation Bible School and we had the opportunity to gather together people from ages 3 to 70+ to use the theme of SPORTS to learn about Jesus and God's love for us all. The best part of being on a sports team is sharing experiences together. Success comes from cooperation and respect, even when someone makes a mistake. Even Jesus chose a team to show us what TEAM Spirit is all about.

Our verse for the week was "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." (Ephesians 4:32, NIV). As we focused on teamwork, we used the Bible to learn how Jesus worked together with his team of disciples to spread the love of God.

"Give me the "T" - Team means We, not Me!

Jesus Chooses His Team (Matthew 4:18–22; 9:9; Mark 1:16–34; John 1:35–51; Luke 5:1–11). We were introduced to a God who loves us and wants us on his team. We discovered that we have TEAM Spirit when we partner with others to accomplish goals. Through teamwork we can accomplish more than when we are alone.

"Give me the "E" - Everyone deserves my respect

Jesus Shows Respect (Luke 19:1–10). We discovered that everyone deserves respect because they were created by and loved by God. The Bible tells us that God created people in His image. That alone makes each person worthy of respect. Some people may act in ways that make us question their worthiness for respect. However we must remember that God created these people too. Even when we can't respect their behavior, we can respect them as people made in the image of God.

In the Bible, Jesus showed respect to Zacchaeus, a person deemed undeserving by most people. When Jesus showed love and respect to Zacchaeus, it changed his life. Zacchaeus changed his dishonest ways and became a follower of Jesus. When we show respect to everyone, it can change lives. That is a powerful motivator for showing respect.

Give me the "A" - All of us make mistakes.

Jesus Fixes Peter's Mistake Luke 22:47-51

We discovered that we all make mistakes and that God will forgive us when we ask for His help. Just as we all make mistakes and need forgiveness, we have also all been on the receiving end of mistakes. When that happens, we actually need to give forgiveness just as much as we need to receive forgiveness. Choosing to forgive keeps us spiritually and emotionally healthy. We all make and are the victims of mistakes. How we respond makes all the difference.

Give me the "M" - My attitudes and actions matter.

Jesus Forgives Others (Matthew 27:11–50; Luke 23:1–48). We discovered that Jesus can help us choose to have good attitudes and actions. Our Bible story this day was about how Jesus was betrayed and crucified, but still responded with love and forgiveness. He is the ultimate example of how important actions and attitudes are. His forgiveness gives hope to the world and makes it possible for people to have a relationship with God. Jesus made it possible for all of us to join God's team.

Team Spirit!

Jesus Promises the Holy Spirit (Acts 1 and 2)

We discovered that the Holy Spirit can help us to be good teammates with Jesus. This Bible story was about Jesus promising to send the best team member of all, the Holy Spirit. For Christians it can be hard to make the choices God wants us to make and tell people about Jesus. We need to understand that when we are a part of Jesus' team, we are not alone. We not only have each other to support us, but we have the power of the Holy Spirit to guide us and give us power. He can give us the strength to make the right choice even when it is difficult. He is the ultimate team member. He fills us with TEAM Spirit that really makes a difference. May God bless our ministry together as a team who wants to win people for Jesus Christ!
