When I was in my senior high youth group in church, I was asked to read this passage from Ecclesiastes 3 during our morning worship service. It was on a Sunday when we were recognizing all the seniors in our church who were graduating from high school.

I remember how that morning worship service was such a joyful time of celebration for all of us in the church! We had several seniors that year who achieved their accomplishment of graduation! The writer of Ecclesiastes speaks about this:

"I know that nothing is better for them than to rejoice, and to do good in their lives, and also that every man should eat and drink and enjoy the good of all his labor- it is the gift of God." (Ecclesiastes 3:12-13)

But the writer of Ecclesiastes also speaks about the people who are dealing with a loss of life. "To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven: A time to be born, And a time to die." (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2)

We have been experiencing a time, in our church, where we have had several deaths. All of us struggle with death, in our own way. For some people, death is "the end," but for others, death is the beginning our new and resurrected life with Jesus in heaven. But how does God see death?

For the writer of Ecclesiastes, death is just one of many chapters in life that God created: "He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end." (Ecclesiastes 3:11)

God has a purpose and a reason for every chapter in our lives. We can expect times of sorrow, but in the end, we are re-assured that God is in control of every chapter in life.

But the greatest celebration is what God did as an answer for death; He sent Jesus: As the apostle Paul said in I Corinthians 15:54-55 "Death is swallowed up in victory. O Death, where is your sting? O Hades where is your victory? The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law, but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

If we follow Jesus we will live our lives in victory! Thanks be to God!
