Read Acts 16:25-34

What happens when a church is in crisis? Prayer, and the gospel message of Jesus Christ is the only solution to that crisis. This is what happened to the Philippian jailer who was ready to commit suicide: He got saved, and he heard the word of the Lord after there was prayer for him.

The setting of the scene in Acts 16:25-34 is a jail cell. Paul and Silas got thrown in this prison for preaching the salvation of Jesus Christ to a girl who was practicing witchcraft, and making a profit out of fortune telling. Paul and Silas had the boldness to pray and cast out the evil spirit in this girl. And when the people saw that this profit business of fortune telling was in trouble, this girl's master took Paul and Silas to the authorities, and they threw Paul and Silas in jail.

When they were in jail, Paul and Silas were not shaken; instead they prayed and sang hymns to God. The Bible says after this that, "Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken.." Then the Philippian jailer was about to kill himself, when Paul and Silas came to his rescue and told him about Jesus. Then the jailer, and his household were saved!

I believe this passage has a similar message for the church today. The church today is in a crisis. Like the foundation of the prison which was shaken by an earthquake, the foundation of the church is being shaken. And the only way the church can be saved is through prayer and the preaching of the gospel message.

And we as Christians should not be shaken by anything that would interfere in proclaiming the Gospel message! Instead we need to be faithful in prayer and the listening of the Word of God. This needs to be our goal, as a church, for the rest of the year. I pray that we, as a church, can be faithful in getting back to the basics of proclaiming the Gospel Message to all people.
