25 "And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring; 26 men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 27 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. 28 Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near." 29 Then He spoke to them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees. 30 When they are already budding, you see and know for yourselves that summer is now near. 31 So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near. 32 Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all things take place. 33 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. 34 "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. 35 For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. 36 Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man."

Read Luke 21:25-36

If you would ask anyone what Christmas means to them, I doubt that they would say, "The Coming of Jesus Christ With Power and Glory." Instead, they would say, "The Coming of Santa Clause to my House!"

But the Biblical Message of Christmas begins with "The Coming of Jesus Christ." That is the meaning of the word "Advent; The Coming of Jesus." Advent is a time of preparation and reflection in anticipation of Christmas, the celebration of Christ's birth.

The church observes four Sunday's of the Advent season. Four candles on the Advent wreath are light for each of the four Sunday's of Advent. Each Sunday of Advent has a different theme of Love, Joy, Hope, and Peace.

When we look at the Biblical Text for the season of Advent, we see that it focuses on The Coming of Jesus Christ. Christmas is more than the Christmas traditions, which all of us observe. It is all about the Coming of our Savior to a lost and sinful world. It is a time when we examine our hearts before God.

Jesus talks about the "Coming of the Son of Man," and He tells us to "take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectantly." (Luke 21:34)

Christmas is the time of the year when many people have hearts that are "weighed down." We might feel the burden of Christmas shopping. Some people have depression at Christmas time because of the "cares of this life." What is the answer to these burdens during the holidays?

Jesus tells us to "watch and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." (Luke 21:36)

As we approach the season of Advent, think on these things that Jesus tells us. Watch, and be aware of your own heart before God. May we focus our hearts and minds on our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ as we celebrate His arrival.
