Consignment Sale How-To

- You will need to obtain a consignor number from Myerstown Church of the Brethren.
 - Contact Jessica Singer (jl.singer@hotmail.com) or Leslie Fuhrman (<u>leslie.noll@comcast.net</u>)
 - A \$10 registration fee is required for every sale
 - This number is unique to you and will be a tracing method for your payment.
 - Numbers are carried over from sale to sale, once you have been assigned a number, it is yours to use for subsequent sales.
 - If you have consigned with a different sale, please contact Jessica or Leslie to see if the number is available for use.
- Tagging your items
 - o All clothing items **must** be hung on appropriately sized hangers.
 - Small items such as socks and onesies can be placed in plastic Ziploc bags
 - No other clothing items will be accepted in bags.
 - Non-clothing items can be labeled individually or placed into large Ziploc bags and sold as a set.
 - Any items containing loose parts must be contained in the original box or in large plastic Ziploc bags. Myerstown Church of the Brethren is not responsible for lost items/pieces.
 - o Every item must be labeled as follows:



• Tag should be fixed to the front of the sale item using safety pins or a tagging gun.

NOTE: No damaged items will be accepted. All clothing should be stain free and not contain holes or show extensive wear. Toys should be in working order and contain all pieces.

Item drop off

- All items must be dropped off the Friday before the scheduled sale between 8am to 3pm and 5pm to 7pm
- It is the responsibility of the consignor assist in hanging/setting up their items.
- Bins/boxes can be stored at the church but **must** be labeled with the consignor's name/number. Myerstown Church of the Brethren is not responsible for lost or misplaced bins/boxes.
- All consignors must fill out a registration form prior to dropping their items at the sale. Registration forms will be available for download from the church website at www.myerstowncob.org

• Item pick up

- All items must be picked up between 2pm and 3:30pm on the day of the sale.
- Any items left on the premises after 3:30pm will be donated.

Payment

- Consignors will receive 65% of profits from their sold items (75% with the full-fillment of a 2 hours volunteer slot. Volunteer slot sign up is on a first come, first serve basis. Slots are available Friday for set-up and Saturday during the sale).
- Checks will be mailed to the address provided on your registration form within 6 weeks of the sale.
