On Wednesday, March 4, we will observe Ash Wednesday which is the first day in the season of Lent. Lent is officially observed in the church as a forty-day period of penitence and prayer, which ends on Easter Sunday.

Some Christians fast during the season of Lent. It is an individual choice. Others choose to give something up during the 40 day period. But Jesus tells us in **Matthew 6**, that when you fast, do not appear before people that you are fasting. "but to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly." (Matthew 6:18)

I was reading about how some Christian traditions observed the 40-day season of Lent. And one thing stood out for me, that we should all observe. Not only did Christians fast, during this season, some Christians included "prayers and charitable works." I thought that would be a good way for us to observe the season of Lent.

In the Gathering Place at church, there are copies of a Lenten Devotional which I would encourage everyone to look at. The devotional is entitled, "New World Coming." The author's name in Edward Poling, and he makes the following statement:

"Lent is a season for transformation, a time to turn inward and consider the health of our own souls. It's a time for the rediscovery of our spirituality, examining where we are faithfully following Jesus, as well as where we miss the mark. It will not be through the stroking of our egos, or the advancement of our personal agenda. It is a passage of humility, obedience, servanthood, and even death."

In this Lenten devotional, you will be led to the three chapters of Matthew 5-7, which is Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. Through these readings, along with your prayers, you will be stretched to grow in your faith in Jesus Christ! And may we all grow together, as we move through Holy Week and Easter, and remember the sacrificial death and Resurrection of our Lord! HOPE TO SEE YOU SUNDAY!
