Read Acts 2:1-21

Pentecost Sunday

What would the "Day of Pentecost" look like in the church today? A better question to think about is, "would God do this miracle in the church today?"

One way to answer this question is to look at the current situation of the overall church today,. How much are people committed to the church today; <u>plus</u>, <u>how committed are people in desiring to grow in their spiritual life with God?</u> Is the church seeking spiritual growth?

I believe most of us would say that the church has shifted over the years: Many people and families are not as committed to the church today, compared to the 1960's and 1970's or even the 1980's. But the number of people in church is not the biggest concern; the biggest concern is a lack of spiritual depth.

Let's look at the spiritual life of the church during the time of Pentecost. In Malachi 4:4, God told Israel, "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord". What happened next, in time, was that there was 400 years where God was completely silent: There were no prophets sent to the people and the nation of Israel. Why? I can only believe that the people were far removed from God.

Then, came the Day of Pentecost, where God made Himself known in a mighty way! In Acts 2:2 the Bible says "And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting".

The main point to know about the Day of Pentecost is that it all came "**from heaven**". It was all of God, and nothing to do with man, or denominations. God spoke from heaven! And it came at a time when people were far removed from God.

The church might not experience another Day of Pentecost; only God knows. But the people in the church can always commit themselves to spiritual grown in the Lord. And watch the Lord do a work!

Mark your calendar for June 9th Pentecost Sunday. Look forward to seeing you in church!
