Ministry through Faith, Vision, and Action

Read Exodus 14:30-31

In honor of Independence Day on July 4th I will devote my page on a very important topic, which is the birth of our nation.

Exodus, chapters 1-14 records the liberation of God's chosen people, from the oppression of the Egyptians. Through the ten plagues, and by the crossing of the Red Sea, God delivered His chosen people to begin a new nation.

David Barton, in his article from the "Founding Father's Bible," makes the comparison of our Founding Fathers to the liberation of God's people, as it is recorded in Exodus. Barton says this:

"This entire Biblical narrative was a source of inspiration to the Founding Fathers, who saw themselves in similar circumstances of oppression and tyranny from which they pleaded for Divine intervention and deliverance."

Patrick Henry, in his famous "Give Me Liberty Or Give Me Death," speech in 1775 in Virginia, reminded the people of the pillar of cloud and the pillar of fire which guided the children of Israel (**Exodus 13:21-22**); of the water gushing from the rock of Horeb (**Exodus 17:6**); and of the miraculous passage of the Red Sea (**Exodus 14**) Patrick Henry concluded by declaring that:

"The same God still ruled in the heavens- that He was watching from His throne the oppressions of His people in America, and that He was still strong to deliver and mighty to save." (Psalm 24:8, Zephaniah 3:17)

The following year, in 1776, our nation was founded. On July 2, 1776, Congress voted to approve the complete separation from the tyranny rule of King George III, from Great Britain. And on July 4, 1776, Congress approved the new Declaration of Independence.

On the Liberty Bell, these words are inscribed, which is taken from Leviticus 25:10 "Proclaim liberty throughout the land unto all inhabitants thereof."

As we honor July 4th, think about the honor and sacrifice our Founding Fathers made for us in establishing our nation, and let us thank God for the United States of America!
