Scriptural Message

4 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted[a] by the devil. 2 After fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. 3 The tempter came to him and said, “If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread.” 4 Jesus answered, “It is written: ‘Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.’[b]” 5 Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple. 6 “If you are the Son of God,” he said, “throw yourself down. For it is written: “‘He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.’[c]” 7 Jesus answered him, “It is also written: ‘Do not put the Lord your God to the test.’[d]” 8 Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. 9 “All this I will give you,” he said, “if you will bow down and worship me.” 10 Jesus said to him, “Away from me, Satan! For it is written: ‘Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.’[e]” 11 Then the devil left him, and angels came and attended him.

Read Matthew 4:1-11

February 26, marks the first day of Lent, which is Ash Wednesday. Then we have 40 days until Easter.

For many people, the first day of Lent means they will give-up something they like for Lent. This is taken from the example in the Bible where Matthew records Jesus being tempted by satan in the desert for 40 days.

But I believe many people today, do not know exactly how Jesus was tempted by satan, and what that means for Lent. The first temptation was physical hunger. Jesus told satan “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.” (Matt. 4:4)

Many people look at this and say that they need to give-up food. That might be good, however, I believe it is better to do what Jesus says and ‘live on the Word of God.’ Make God’s Word more of a priority for Lent this year.

In my sermons that I preach each Sunday, I have always made it a priority to use scripture as my main resource. Some would call this ‘expository preaching,’ where preachers give their messages straight out of the Bible. Make the Word of God your priority during the season of Lent.

The second temptation of Jesus was the temptation to not rely on God for His sustenance. Satan told Jesus to just jump off a cliff because God will save you! Just be a miracle worker for yourself! But Jesus told satan “It is written again, ‘You shall not tempt the Lord your God.’ (Matt. 4:7)

We are not miracle workers for God. Instead, we are to trust God day to day. The Bible says faith in God is “the evidence of things not seen.” (Hebrews 11:1) Strengthen your faith in God, during Lent, by trusting Him with the things that we cannot see and know for sure.

The third temptation of Jesus was to always put God first in your life, above the worldly attractions. The devil told Jesus that He could have “all the kingdoms of the world and their glory.” But Jesus told him, “Away with you, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only shall you serve.” (Matthew 4:10)

This is probably the most important temptation of all! How are we putting God first in our lives? What things are we putting ahead of God in our lives?

This is where we need confession. During this season of Lent, let us confess anything to God where we have neglected Him, and put something higher than Him. Make this season of Lent a season of true repentance and confession, and may we always make our Lord our highest priority!
