On June 21 we opened the church for in-person worship. We've been averaging 48-50 people each Sunday. From my perspective things have been going well. People are social distancing and for the most part wearing masks. Thanks to Earl Liskey for arranging for special music for each service and to those who have provided it, to Barb H. and Barb W. for their musical leadership, and for all who have volunteered to be worship leaders. I've especially enjoyed having some real live children for a children's message!

During the past month there have been a number of members who have been hospitalized, fortunately none for COVID-19. I've tried to follow-up with phone calls as hospital visits are still not allowed.

A new Bible study began on Monday, July 20 with eight people attending. My intention was to try to make it available in person at the church and also online, however, it seemed some who wanted to join online were not able to connect. I'll be working on why that didn't work so they can join for the next session.

As we are getting back together in some limited ways, it seems now is time to start thinking about the future. I personally think it still too soon to think about a search committee (What would you say in your congregational profile right now?), but a good time to do some envisioning for the future and working to get the church back on track.
