Pastor's Report

July 22, 2020 - August 18, 2020

Since we opened the church for in-person worship on June 21 we have been seeing an increase in attendance from the upper forties when we started to the mid-seventies the past couple of Sundays. Again, people seem to be respecting social distancing and are wearing masks according to our re-opening guidelines. It was good to have the Bell Choir provide music for one Sunday. I am thankful for the contributions of Barb Heffner and Barb Weidman, for those who have been providing special music, for Barb Weidman and Earl Liskey who have been serving as choristers, and for those who have volunteered to serve as worship leaders. It has also been good seeing the number of children coming forward for the children's story increasing.

I have been in touch with Jim Bauer regarding the spiritual renewal services in October. The Deacons have requested to have pew communion sometime this fall in place of Love Feast. Jim and I decided we will do that on Sunday, October 4.

Fortunately, the number of persons in the congregation being hospitalized has been small. When possible I am trying to connect on the phone. If I can't reach them in the hospital, then when they return home. I have noticed a few times recently when members were hospitalized and I was not aware until after the fact. Please contact me when a family member or member of the church is hospitalized so I can make contact with them.

The Monday evening Bible study is going well with twelve people attending at the church and four attending online via Zoom.

There has been some interest expressed in getting Sunday School and choir going again. These will both require more discussion on how we handle these activities.
