#### A New Normal

Welcome to summer 2021! It is looking more and more like this summer might be a little more "normal" as vaccination rates increase and some of the restrictions like occupancy limits and the requirement for wearing masks (for those who have been vaccinated) begin to be relaxed. We've made some small steps here at the church as masks are now optional and the center section of the sanctuary has been fully reopened.

While we look forward to a return to normalcy, many are saying what the future holds is not so much a return to what was before February 2020, but instead a "new normal." For Myerstown Church of the Brethren, I think this "new normal" is going to be one filled with hope and promise and several things happening this month of June point us toward that "new normal" in the life of the church.

First of all, we will welcome a new member through the ordinance of Christian baptism on June 13. It is always a highlight in the life of the church when a new believer enters the baptismal waters. I also have been asked by another one of our younger attenders about baptism and we will look forward to another to enter the waters this fall. These new believers are the future of the church. God has plans for Myerstown CoB, plans which give us hope as we look to the future. It is my hope and prayer that these baptisms will be first of many to come.

Another sign of a "new normal" in the life of the church is the proposed job description for a part-time Children and Youth Coordinator which will be brought to the June Church Council meeting. For me, it has been a sign of hope to have 4-8 children join me for a Children's Message each Sunday morning. These children are the future of the church. One way you can commit to them is to provide for a dynamic children and youth program here at Myerstown CoB.

Since we returned to in-person worship a faithful group of volunteers has led children's Sunday School and Children's Church, but the reality is that the pool of volunteers is limited. While the volunteers have done an amazing job, for the children's and youth programs to grow and thrive, a leader giving undivided attention to the programs is needed. These young children in the congregation are the promise of a youth program in the future. In fact, there are some youth who are not attending regularly who could also be part of a renewed youth program at the church.

Moving ahead with the hiring of a part-time coordinator sends the message to the children, their parents and the community that the

church is committed to providing a dynamic program which will lead these children and youth to faith in Christ.

Through Jeremiah, God told the exiled Israelites, "For I know the plans I have for you, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

God is at work here at Myerstown Church of the Brethren! The "new normal" God has in store for this church is beginning to unfold. The question is, are we willing to join in what God is doing?

In his letter to the Ephesians, Paul prays, "Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen." (Ephesians 3:20-21 NRSV)
