Ministry through Faith, Vision, and Action

On Sunday, September 26 and continuing through the Sunday before Thanksgiving my sermons will focus on the theme of "Calling." Sermon themes and Scriptures are as follows:

September 26: *Called to Flourish* (Matthew 22:34-40 & Ephesians 3:8-21)

October 3: (Pew Communion – Spiritual Enrichment – David Stauffer preaching)

October 10: *A Lost Church for a Lost World* (Ezekiel 33:1-9 & Matthew 5:13-16)

October 17: *The Primary Call* (Mark 1:16-20, 10:17-21; Colossians 2:6-7 & 1 Peter 2:21)

October 24: *Relocating: Where We Are Called* (Jeremiah 29:1, 4-7; Titus 3:1-8 & 1 Peter 2:11-12)

November 7: *Reorienting; How are we called*? (Romans 12:1-2 & Luke 5:1-11)

November 14: *The Way of Wisdom* (James 3:13-18 & Proverbs 1:20-21, 2:2-3)

November 21: (Thanksgiving Sunday) *First Things* (Deuteronomy 26:1-11 & Colossians 3:12-17)

Our annual Spiritual Enrichment services will be held October 3, 4, and 5. Dave Stauffer is our guest speaker. Dave and his wife, Beth, live at Brethren Village and are members at East Fairview Church of the Brethren. Dave is a retired pastor who serves as our congregation's moderator. Dave will continue this theme of "calling" using the Great Commission from Matthew 28:16-20 as a text in each service. There will be music and a children's message at each service. Here are the themes for the services.

• Sunday, October 3, 10:00 AM: "The Faith We Examine." In preparation for communion, we will consider what it means to believe in Jesus, follow Jesus, and serve Jesus while dealing with our doubts and sins. A key verse will be: Examine yourselves, and only then eat of the bread and drink of the cup (1 Corinthians 11:28).

• Sunday, October 3, 7:00 PM: "The Faith We Embody." We will consider how to make the faith we confess with our lips be the faith we demonstrate with our behavior. A key verse will be: For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you (John 13:15).

• Monday, October 4, 7:00 PM: "The Faith We Extend." We will consider how to make disciples who will know and accept Jesus as Savior and Lord. A key verse will be: Proclaim the message; be persistent whether the time is favorable or unfavorable; convince, rebuke, and encourage, with the utmost patience in teaching (2 Timothy 4:2).

• Tuesday, October 5, 7:00 PM: "The Abiding Presence of Christ." We will consider the difference it makes to believe that God is with us. A key verse will be: And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age (Matthew 28:20b).

I look forward to seeing you on Sunday mornings and hope you will plan on attending the three evening Spiritual Enrichment services.
