The meeting opened with prayer by Dave Dubble.

Worship leaders are in place for October 23 – Kim Horn and October 30 – Mark Landis, Sr. Pastor Chris said he would like to see more input from the worship leaders instead of a structured plan as to what to use each Sunday.

The Gospel Music Program this past Sunday was a success with a good attendance. We decided to schedule it again next year and are looking to Sunday, October 15th at 3:00 pm.

Renewal Service held the beginning of October wasn't well attended. We will be looking for a date for 2023 and are thinking about holding it the week prior to Love Feast. We are also looking for suggestions for speakers and it will be called Spiritual Enrichment Service.

We discussed the possibility of having a Men's Prayer Breakfast and we are looking for suggestions from Church Board.

We discussed having a Children & Adult Program in the spring and the possibility of having Chris Ivey, a Christian Juggler.

We also discussed having a Men's Choir from Harmony Christian Fellowship.

Technology Report Update

The recording and broadcasting capabilities of the audio-visual technologies installed in the church are being used continuously. In addition to live streaming and recording services the technology provided an opportunity for home-bound Pastor Dennis to present the morning sermon from his home on October 16.

Recently one of the old pieces of equipment, a video splitter, failed. Charlie Krall replaced it with a different model that works very well.

We were notified that the new projectors have shipped.

The AV team is growing. Two new operators are in training.

Communication has begun with the Church of the Brethren Faith in Action Committee to guide us in developing an extension of our grant of 2021. The goal of this grant will be to extend the outreach of our ministries utilizing the technology that has already been put into place, and to improve the experience of those persons attending in the church through the installation of improved projection devices and networking capabilities.
